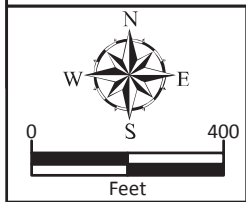


**Notes:**  
 Lack of flow direction on map indicates that spills will pool around container with negligible migration prior to implementation of spill response measures.

Knox reserves parking space for MFTs based on mission requirements, ranging from zero to six MFTs. MFTs may include 600 gallon tank-and-pump unit (TPU) trucks, 3,000 gallon HeavyExpanded Mobility Tactical Trucks (HEMTTs), and 5,000 gallon MFT trailers.

The number of pieces of mobile tactical hydraulic equipment varies based on mission requirements, ranging from zero to three of each type of equipment. Equipment reservoirs range from zero to 299 gallons.
